


So a little revision of yesterday, we decided we would deal first with the external and then we would look at the internal history. Because the **internal** overlays or **connects** with the **external**. I wanted us to keep one thought in mind. All through this study, which are the same points that were made in the last dispensation with that message. And that point is that we don't live in a vacuum.

What is occurring is not all about me and it is not all about you. It's not all about the priesthood but what is occurring, a preparation of a people worldwide. It begins with you and I, it begins with the priesthood. Because it will be our duty to go and teach other people. But all that preparation to either reject or accept that message occurs without us. Plowing, early rain and latter rain.

We know the harvest of the world begins at the Sunday Law. Prior to the Sunday Law there is an agitation of that coming issue. We can fractalize that and expect an agitation prior to 2014, 2019 and 2021. But just to go straight to the main application of Ellen White's words on that subject. If we're going to mark an agitation it would be 2021. And we are two months away from 2021. We should all be familiar of the subject in the fractals that is being agitated even

for the 144,000. You and I are here.>

We are physically seeing the agitation develop. We are not alone, in that while they don't know what that is, prophetically, the entire world is watching the agitation develop. This is part of it to, increase knowledge for the 144,000, that began last year and it's growing, swelling.



So we discussed the waymark of Concord, this

dispensation, is harvest time, that's the increase of knowledge in this dispensation.

We take Concorde from the increase of knowledge in Millerite history and understand that that was fulfilled May 25 with the death of George Floyd. Concorde lines up with the beginning of the counter revolution, which lines up with the increase knowledge, its one waymark. But we have been discussing the nature of fractals and lastly we discussed the nature of a waymark and how it tells a story.

So George Floyd sparks a counterrevolution. The point of that counterrevolution could easily have been lost. There's been protest before but not on this scale for about 50 years, not on this level. But there were particularly four deaths in that history that have kept the subject of civil rights in front of a wide group of people and have made it for many who try to avoid the subject, it's made it more and more difficult to do.

I looked back at my friends in Adventism, I see two groups. I see one group that is fighting against government lock down, drowning in conspiracy theories. They are socially conservative, they believe that efforts against the pandemic is taking away their rights. It's interesting to understand what is occurring. I keep an eye on conservative Catholic media. Taylor Marshall, church militant and the worldview that they are espousing, conservative Catholics, is in many ways identical to my conservative Adventist friends. (Taylor Reed Marshall is an American Catholic YouTube commentator, apologist, writer, and former academic known for his advocacy for traditionalist Catholicism and his involvement in Donald Trump's 2020 presidential campaign. He is the author of multiple books...) One Cardinal recently wrote an article about the dangers of a coronavirus vaccine. That it may contain small parts of fetal tissue. (In the US, some Catholic bishops are discouraging people from getting the latest single-shot vaccine from Johnson & Johnson when alternatives are available because it contains lab-grown cells that descend from cells taken in the



1980s from the tissue of aborted fetuses. CNN) It's going to be rolled out by dictatorial left-wing governments pushed upon the people and this dangerous vaccine will be seen as a sign of the end times. The exact same world view being espoused by my Adventist friends.

Then I see other friends with there head in the sand. Trying to pretend that nothing has changed in the world, to such an extent that they don't dare talk about the raging pandemic, because they are afraid of confrontation, so they continue their lives in this fantasy

world while it's burning around them. And for those people with not just the death of George Floyd but these other losses, as much as they try not to look at these events, are forcing them to look. So people have no excuse at the end of the world.

This is the waymark of the Death Decree, and there are four other significant deaths in this time period. They keep the issues of equality and civil rights in front of the people.


Two addressed the subject of **race** and **nationalism** and two the subject of **sexism**. The two that address racism, John Lewis and Chadwick Boseman.





John Lewis fought/protested in the civil rights movement, he was a leading member. Became known as the conscience of Congress.

Two relate to sexism, Ruth Bader Ginsberg and Helen Reddy. Helen Reddy



became or wrote the theme song for second wave feminism. What was our RBG famous for? On the Supreme Court, every time the court made a decision that went against her belief system, sister to Tamina says, **Descent**. She would write a really neat dissent. fierv with some passion. She was famous for her descents. What does your conscience



do? It's operating all the time, but you feel it when it

starts to hurt you. When people start to be aware that they have a conscience, it's because that conscious just told him that they were bad. It reproved them. So when John Lewis becomes the conscience of Congress, what is he saying to Congress? All the way they are wicked.


Ellen White describes the **death decree** as an attempt to silence **reproof** and **dissent**. **We find in this time period that's what is lost. Dissent on the Supreme** <u>Court</u> and the Reproof in the <u>Congress</u>. This waymark began with a death and ended with a death. Racism and sexism. And the entire theme is counterrevolution over equality. 19:08

The first deaths sparked waves of protests. The death of Helen Reddy was on the same day as the first presidential debate of 2020. At least most of us would be familiar with that debate, it was a counter revolution against the counter revolution. As Donald Trump attacked the protesters and the cause of the revolution. And what group did he tacitly endorse? He was asked to condemn white supremacy, he failed to do so even afterwords when everyone is angry with him, for what he said at the debate, he tries to defend himself by claiming then to condemn white supremacy. But that would be to condemn his own supporters. So he can't even just say I condemn white supremacy. Even then it is coded in more vague language. But at the debate he said essentially there is no far right supremacy problem. Almost everything is those radical leftist. And he told one group, the Proud Boys as they're known, stand back and standby which is not a condemnation, it's more a call to waiting and be ready to act. Because he said, "someone has to do something about the radical left."

Recently when Carl Rittenhouse, travels to a different state where there were

protests, shoots and kills two black protesters. Fox News responds by saying, "well someone had to do something." So protesters fighting for equality are described as the radical left with no actual cause. And a 17 year old killing two black protesters in cold blood is seen as the defense of law and order.

We all know the perspective between Donald Trump and Fox News is identical. The Proud Boys is a far right, neofascist, male only organization that promotes and engages in political violence in the United States and Canada. It has been described by the United States Intelligence Organization as a dangerous white supremacist group. They denied being racist but it's founder once said,



"I love being white and I think it's something to be very proud of. I don't want our culture to be diluted, we need to close the borders now and let everyone assimilate to a western, white, English speaking way of life." If that does not sound like Hitler I don't know what does. And how do you have a country assimilate to whiteness when a large part of your population is black? How they're being diluted by their own population, their own citizens.

To enter this organization you take an oath and you say, "I am a western chauvinist. I refuse to apologize for creating the modern world." So the second part creating a modern world, that's revisionist history. The title of being a chauvinist, they wear it with pride. The definition of chauvinism is that you are superior to other people.


You can be a male chauvinist, men are superior to women, regional chauvinist believe that your area or country is better than everyone else's and then just blind patriotism for your country. So you can be chauvinist against women, men are superior, your region is superior, your country is superior and they hold to all three. Because they would say that white men created the modern world.

They miss being proud to be men. So their actual name is indicative of their approach to women not their approach to race but they are against both

feminism and civil rights. So at this debate, which was horrific, you had Trump give tacit endorsement for this organization.

I won't read from this article, but it was posted at the time of the debate, Washington post article about the Proud Boys. So if you go back a couple weeks it won't be far off your feed but I won't read it for time. It's titled Trump stand by remarks puts the Proud Boys in the spotlight. It's a relatively small organization. What Trump did was not just espouse that organization but their entire ideology. So it's an endorsement of Chauvinism and White Supremacy. So it's not just about the organization, everyone else who espouses that ideology is going to feel vindicated.

It's around this debate time that Trump comes down with COVID-19. Everything facing him on that day made him weak, the pandemic the protest and his personal health. So what he had to do in the debate was to project strength. And that's what we find him attempting to do. He's under attack for his conspiracy theory's, his reaction to the protests, his reaction to the pandemic. So he goes on the attack against all three. The whole point of this waymark, every waymark is to inform and then divide two groups of people. It creates Concord and two groups of people.



This is the Death Decree, who is in Concord at the Death Decree?

In the history of the disciples it's the upper room, it's the disciples, it's the good side. At the Death Decree, what is highlighted is the bad side. The enemies of the message, the enemies of the message of equality. Proud boys, white supremacists, Donald Trump.

From May 25 to September 29 it's the story of **two groups coming into Concord. Not with each other but their own ideology.** This movement comes into Concord, enemies of the movement come into Concord. Those espousing equality coming to Concord and those attacking equality coming into Concord. So people coming into Concord from all different nationalities and backgrounds to protest against inequality. But just like the civil rights era that doesn't just happen on its own. You have the unifying of the opposition to that movement.

George Floyd > May 25 John Lewis → July 17 Chadwick Boseman → Aug. 28 RBG → Sep. 18

So it <u>begins</u> with a Death and <u>ends</u> with a < Death.

Concorde of one movement, Concord of the opposition. The silencing of Reproof and Dissent. Civil rights second wave feminism also impacting the

media industries, and entertainment. Forcing the world to look at the issues and make a decision. To pick a side. (Plowing)

It's already Thursday for me so I want to move on and we have dealt with revolution as much as we are going to.


I want to briefly remind us of the history of ancient Israel. Just two questions before we do that.

First question, it's a little disconnected but someone in the French world asked this before the camp meeting so I wanted to address it.

It's a question we've had quite a few times. About how to identify true information from false information. I want to give some tools and suggestions. The first one is a series posted on the media broadcast it is all in English


unfortunately for some. It's by <u>Crash Course</u>. It doesn't take long to go through, I did it in a day. They're about 13 minute presentations and their entitled <u>Navigating Digital</u> <u>Information.</u>

This is a great resource.



They did this in conjunction with Media Wise in the Stanford History Education Group. They break the whole issue of media literacy down really well.

There's one other resource and this is **Media Bias Fact Check.** So if you write the name of the news organization you are looking at, Media Bias Fact Check.



They have a scale between extreme left and extreme right. In the center is entitled least bias. 43:21 (reliability goes from top to bottom, most to least reliable)

So I've already said we're not centrist, and the information I look for on their page, it's not about the politics that they espouse because we ourselves have a

bias, prophecy forces us to have a bias but its how they use information.

Do they use correct sources or engage in conspiracies? The second is, do they do this in an <u>emotional</u> way, intended to <u>manipulate</u>? So I looked up Fox News on this fact check and they sell both. They are strongly bias towards the right.

They appeal to emotion and stereotypes, publish



misleading reports and omit reporting of information that damages conservative causes. They then give examples of stories taught by this news source that our false.

For example, far more children died last year drowning in their bathtub then were killed by guns. That's faults. So it list all the examples of times they have published false news. Some sources have both good and bad aspects. So Fox News I would never use. But something like AI Jazeera if you look them up and



Media Bias Fact Check, they have a slight liberal bias. They can use emotional words but usually with factual information, described as generally trustworthy.

So they don't engage in this emotional Islam. Except they are a state run news organization. They are owned by the Qatari government. So they are mostly trustworthy but be careful when they say anything about Israel. Now the government has an interest in that reporting. Then they start getting into trouble with strong emotional wording and bias. So it will give you Al Jazeera mostly safe but be aware of that bias. But regardless of the source you use, Crash

Course it gives you the tools to handle that information.

Anyone from Australia? Sky News is Australia's Fox News. This is where Lauren



Southern is now operating. [Lauren Southern is a Canadian alt-right political activist, white nationalist and YouTuber. Altright is a right-wing ideological movement characterized by a rejection of mainstream politics and by the use of online media to disseminate provocative content, often expressing opposition to racial, religious, or gender equality.] They (Sky News Australia) are strongly bias towards conservative causes and engage frequently in conspiracy theories.



At the same time Sky News UK, they are slightly left, have highly factual reporting and trustworthy. So Sky News Australia, really bad! Sky News UK safe.

So don't just check the news source check also the country it is reporting from.

The Guardian, it's left-leaning, it's trustworthy but they do use, can use highly emotional headlines, which impacts their rating. They have quite a list of articles

that failed their fact check. Recent one saying that the number of children needing foster care has risen by 44% since the pandemic began. I am giving an example of some of their failed articles. One talking about the coronavirus pandemic saying that the number of children needing foster care has risen by nearly 50%. They posted an article that said firms bidding for government contracts we're being asked if they backed Brexit. So that's left-leaning and



also false. So with our prophetic worldview, right leaning becomes less safe but despite left or right they should use factual sourcing and not engage in unnecessary emotional language. That's manipulation.

Two tools that are good to use is this series (Crash Course) Media Bias Fact Check and there's also really good documentaries put out by Frontline and they are good news sources.


The Guardian for one is quite good but should be checked. So that was to answer a question about how to identify new sources. That hopefully can assist.

Back to our history. As priest you are here. (between 2019 & 2021) 144,000 we are here. (before the SL) Tracing **external** waymarks, we have passed the increase of knowledge for this dispensation, which you would understand has internal implications for this movement. We constructed that particularly by reminding ourselves of the Revolution's. Which is the theme of 2020.

To go back into the prior dispensation. We've used the model of ancient Israel. It's laid out here in its structure so we also understand this to be Pentecost. The disciples go through their time of trouble then they go to work, back to the church then they go to the world at 34AD.

Just to step ourselves through the previous history.

Christ begins his work with the First Temple Cleansing. From here to here (between lst &2nd Temple Cleansing) He's educating the disciples, trying to remove the incorrect world view that they've been imbibing from not just their Jewish leaders and their pharisaical pastors but also from John the Baptist.




We come to see formalization of his message and this is the Triumphal Entry.

Is the nature of the kingdom clear at the Triumphal Entry? No, and it wasn't for us either. There's enough in 2018 to make people uncomfortable 1:02 but it's deliberately kept vague by God. If Christ had truly represented what was about to come at the Triumphal Entry it would not have gained the attention that it needed to. So he allows it to be misleading. There was enough in 2018 to already make people uncomfortable. Sister Tamina ask why?

What would have happened to the message and to the movement if we said in 2018 how far equality was going to take us. It would've been shot down. Few if any would have been able to except or indorse. It would never have spread across the world. Christ is about to be crucified, He wants the attention so that when they do see those events, everyone knows what is happening, everyone knows who He is. So He allows the attention to come. All the disciples are happy, they think this is the fulfillment of their hopes. Finally we have the prediction of time. Judas was excited, he's about to have this king.

And then from the Triumphal Entry through the Upper Room Judas and all the disciples have an increasing realization that this is heading in a direction that they had not anticipated. For many it's painful for Judas it is too much.



So <u>Triumphal Entry</u>, <u>midnight cry</u>, <u>we don't immediately start ordaining women</u>. That takes time to be revealed from October through December the next year. That way that message has gained the attention it needed to gain.


For one ministry in this movement it was too much. They are rejoicing at the formalization but they don't understand it. They know the time is here the Jewish people knew something was about to happen but they don't understand exactly what are the implications. Judas, and all the people know that something is about to happen. FFA knows November 9 is approaching now but what that looks like and the implications about the character of God, the nature of the king and the kingdom is kept hidden at the formalization of that message. And it is gradually revealed and enforced. It reaches a climax in the upper room when Jesus washes the feet, it's a work of organization, it's a statement about the character of His Kingdom. Prior to the cross Judas makes his final decision. He separates and goes back to the idolatry of the Jewish leaders.

FFA separated and went back to the idolatry of conservative evangelical Protestantism and Adventism. Then we have the <u>cross</u>. (Nov. 9,2019) Most people don't understand what is taking place they're going to understand it later.

There is confusion, a scattering, the disciples go back to their previous employment and then with the resurrection of Christ, we have that <u>40 day time</u> <u>period</u>. November 9, 2019 to May 2020.

We have a couple of quotes to read.

The disciples are here (that <u>40</u> <u>day time period</u>) in Acts 1:6 when they come together they ask of him saying "Lord will you now at this time restore The Kingdom to Israel?" So they are here (that 40 day time period)_and they do not understand the message. They don't understand it back here, (before the Triumphal Entry 2018) are confused and don't fully understand or here (40 day time period) and still den't get it here (just after the C



don't get it here. (just after the Cross)

So for 40 days Christ going to teach them what He'd already taught them. And from the end of last year through to May of this year, that's a campmeeting in Australia, campmeeting in Tahiti, camp meeting in Fiji, campmeeting in Kenya, South Sudan, Uganda, Brazil, at school in Uganda, school in Portugal. That's just where I know Elder Parminder and myself taught. Germany as well. And we just retaught what had already been retaught in a previous dispensation. There is some repeat and enlarge. Sorry if I missed anyone it was not intentional.


We are essentially repeating the messages of the last dispensation. Because people are still not understanding Equality or the Sunday Law. Acts 1:3 For 40 days he was seen of them speaking of the things pertaining to the Kingdom of God. They've repeated it, repeated it, repeated it. between what time period? The cross and the increase of knowledge, 40 days. That's the history of ancient Israel.

Modern Israel, between our shut door and the increase of knowledge. November and May. It's a repeat and enforcement. At the ascension, why are the disciples so disappointed?

Their disappointed, sister Tamina says, they still don't understand. If Jesus is in heaven how can you build the Kingdom on earth? So they don't understand don't understand don't understand.(at *the Triumphal Entry, the Cross and the 40 days after the Cross*)


And you're here. (the 40 days after the Cross)

So we do not understand. What is so hard to understand about the Equality? The message is not complete. There is no new rain but the problem is that the latter rain was not understood. It's going to feel like an increase of knowledge and a formalization when it comes. So you're going to feel there is a new message. In every dispensation, the harvest being no exception, there is an increase of knowledge and a formalization. The message when It



comes here, looks innocent, easy, (@ IK) it requires no change of character, over here it's hard. (@ Formalization) Over here it requires you to change. So what we had in a previous dispensation with a message of equality, was not fully understood. So it's going to be repeated but there's parts of it that have been missing from our experience.

This dispensation is about <u>Line Upon Line and Daniel 11:40</u>. This dispensation is about the <u>2520 and Time</u>. This dispensation is about the king of the south and <u>Equality</u>. No new message. Because this dispensation about equality. There's a distinct difference in the message between the plowing, early rain and latter rain.



But the harvest message is not different, it's a repeat and enlarge of the message previously given. Because there's only so much we could hear or except in this dispensation.

I am overtime so I will close.

Concorde - it begins with a Death and ends with a Death. It's all about Equality.

The silencing of reproof and decent at the death decree. Two sides coming into Concord themselves. Those who support equality those who do not support equality. The everlasting gospel creating Concord between two separate groups of people.

We started looking at our internal experience. We trace, just in quick review the story of the disciples. Triumphal entry, it's kept vague. The same time Jesus is weeping over Jerusalem no one understands why he is morning for his country, it's people. It becomes increasingly visible between the triumphal entry and Gethsemane .

The visibility of the foot-washing creates two groups of people.

The disciples are scattered at the cross, there is confusion, they go back to their previous employments, but Jesus at his resurrection returns to them for 40 days. And he's repeating the message of the last dispensation.

So the harvest time. No new message, because these two are different, (*Dan11 & Time*) these two are different.

These two are the same, equality and equality. But it was not completely understood. So **there will still be an Increase of Knowledge and a Formalization about Equality.**

And we will address that in the next presentation.
