We are currently in a prophetic pandemic. The Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome Coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2), or, the 2019 novel coronavirus (2019-nCoV) is the virus that causes COVID-19 (Coronavirus disease 2019). This pandemic might seem new and big, but it actually isn't. The actual virus is new, but a similar pandemic occurred in the 1900s. This pandemic was the 1918 Flu pandemic, or the Spanish Flu. In this lesson we will take a look at the Spanish Flu and see how similar COVID-19 is to it.

World War I

Triple application of Prophecy

This movement has come to an understanding of a TAP (Triple Application of Prophecy). A TAP is when you have three events and the first two were the same so you know what the third will be. It means you can bring one and two together to understand three. A classic example of a TAP are the three Woes. We knew the first and second Woes were the activities of Islam, therefore we could conclude that the third Woe would be the same- not George Bush and the CIA. We're going to be looking at another classic TAP: The World Wars. We can bring World War I and World War II together to understand World War III.

WWI recap

The history of World War I that we line up with our reform line is from 1908 to 1919. The 1908 Bosnian Crisis between Austria-Hungary and Serbia (who was backed by Russia) over Bosnia parallels the crisis between the United States and Iraq (who was backed by Russia) over Kuwait. Then, in both histories, there was a terrorist attack against the King of the North- on June 28, 1914 and September 11, 2001. Next were the circumstances around the Iraq War of 2003 and that was paralleled by the history of July 1914. After that the King of the North (Germany) sent a revolutionist (Lenin) to the King of the South (Russia) to overthrow the government and end the war between the two countries, in 1917. That paralleled Russia (the King of the South) "sending" Donald Trump (a revolutionist) to the King of the North (the USA) to overthrow the establishment and stop the fighting between the two powers, so it can rise to power. The Treaty of Brest-Litovsk on March 3, 1918 parallels the battle of Raphia in 2019. At that time Russia defeated the United States and in one perspective they stopped fighting. After that was Armistice Day (November 11, 1918) and the Treaty of Versailles (June 28, 1919)- these events ended WWI; they symbolize Panium (2021) and the Sunday Law.

The Treaty of Brest-Litovsk

The Treaty of Brest-Litovsk is what ended World War I. On March 3, 1918, Russia signed a treaty with the Central Powers (Germany, Austria-Hungry, Bulgaria, and the Ottoman Empire). This treaty took Russia out of World War I, and ended the war on the eastern front, but Russia also faced penalties. Since Russia had lost the war to the Central Powers, it was forced to give up the Baltic states (3 areas controlled by Russia) to Germany, and other of its territories to the Ottoman Empire. Russia was the King of the South and Germany

was the King of the North, so the Treaty of Brest-Litovsk was a victory for the King of the North. It is essential to know, however, that World War I was in an Alpha history, not an Omega.

The Spanish Flu

The Spanish Flu pandemic began on March 11, 1918. It was called the Spanish Flu because it broke out in the time of World War I and during the war, most countries didn't have free media. Spain, who remained neutral throughout the war, did, so they began reporting on it first- that's why other countries thought it originated there. The Spaniards called it the French Flu though. However, it most likely originated in New York state. It infected one third of the world's population and killed 20-50 million people. At the time of the outbreak, there were no drugs to cure it and hospitals became overloaded. Citizens were told to stay home and wear masks, especially higher risk people like those over 65 years old and with other medical conditions. Having people stay at home was detrimental to the economy but the Spanish Flu was highly contagious. It could travel through the air from a sneeze or cough and infect a nearby person through their nose, eyes, or mouth. It originated from birds. The reason it spread so quickly and was so widespread is because soldiers were carrying it around the world and citizens lived very close and did not practice good hygiene back then. Also, a lot of people were simply weakened from the war.


World War III

Raphia 2019

The Treaty of Brest-Litovsk in 1918 is the event that corresponds to Raphia in 2019. In World War I Russia under Lenin surrendered to Germany: the King of the South surrendered to the King of the North. The war between Germany and Russia- the Eastern front- ended. That happened, as we have seen, with the Treaty of Brest-Litovsk on March 3, 1918. With World War I being a history of failure and World War III being a history of success, we know that we have to switch the players when we make application to our time. So that means that in 2019 the King of the North would have to surrender to the King of the South; also their fighting would have to stop. In 2019, Donald Trump did surrender a lot of spheres of influence to Putin- so he (Putin-the King of the South) won more of what he wanted. Also according to WWI the Eastern front ended in 2019. But on other lines the fighting between the KoS and the KoN began in 2019, or just continued; these different perspectives mean that in 2019 we just saw the end of the first phase of the Eastern front according to World War I.

COVID-19

As we have seen, the Treaty of Brest-Litovsk parallels the battle of Raphia in 2019, which was a victory for Putin. Unfortunately, right after the Treaty, a pandemic hit the world. The Spanish flu was unexpected, and claimed tens of millions of lives. The reason it spread so much is because everyone was weakened by the war (WWI). So in our time, the Treaty of Brest-Litovsk parallels 2019. Just like in history, COVID-19 hit the world right after the battle of Raphia- when people were "weakened" from war. The first known case of the virus was on November 17, 2019; that's just 8 days after November 9 even though Raphia was more than one day. The Spanish Flu was so wide spread because of the war; that means COVID-19 is so wide spread also because people are weakened by the war (Raphia). Raphia was an information war, that means people were not weakened physically- they were weakened mentally by Trump's conspiracy theories. Therefore, the real threat of COVID-19 is not the hundreds of thousands of lives it has claimed, the danger is the conspiracy theories about it, because that is where people are weak.

COVID-19 vs the Spanish Flu

The Spanish Flu of 1918 and COVID-19 of 2019 are very much alike. We lined up the history of World War I with World War III. From that line upon line we know the Treaty of Brest-Litovsk lines up with November 9, 2019. Eight days after the treaty, the Spanish Flu pandemic began. Eight days after November 9, 2019 the Coronavirus pandemic began. Along with that we saw the similarities between the two virus themselves. They both are highly contagious and infect the same population the hardest and require the same measures to mitigate the spread. The Spanish Flu pandemic lasted until 1919 (the year after it started) so will the COVID-19 pandemic end this year? We know it will end before Panium in 2021 (because the seven last plagues end before the Second Advent).

COVID-19 vs the seasonal flu

Conspiracy theories are the methodology of the false stream and we know that we are not supposed to believe them. There are some false ideas that people have about COVID-19. Some have said that it isn't worse than the seasonal flu and that it will go away quickly. That is wrong. The common seasonal flu infects around 3 to 5 million people, severely, a year and around 290,000 to 650,000 people die- without social distancing. COVID-19 currently has over 4 million cases and over 295 thousand deaths- with social distancing. The flu spreads from one person to around 1.3 people and COVID-19 spreads from one person to about 2 to 3 people. The death rate for the flu is 0.1% (not taking into account people who don't have symptoms); COVID-19's death rate is 3-4% (also not taking into account people who don't have symptoms). Also, experts are saying that a second wave is coming in the Fall- COVID-19 isn't going away soon. People are trying to downplay the virus but we should know that it is serious and a subject of Bible prophecy.
